Reflection 2nd Sunday Lent

This is my Son, Listen to him.

In the cloud and the mist the disciples were afraid. They had climbed the mountain with Jesus, as they had been through tough times with him - times when people rejected him, mocked his sermons in the synagogue, condemned his compassion for people, and now they had seen his glory - They had seen him at the best humanity could offer and they had seen what divinity looked like, the glory of God on the face of Jesus.
