OFFERTORY COLLECTIONS LAST SUNDAY

Both 1st and 2nd Collections are sent into the Diocesan Offices where they are distributed equitably. However, the Planned Giving envelopes collection is retained in the Parish and is used for the day to day running costs such as light, heat, staff, insurance etc.

First Collection (Common Fund) amounted to €1,057.00

Second (Share) Collection amounted to € 961.00

Thursday 15th August is the Feast of the Assumption of our Lady, Masses will be at 10am and 12 noon. No Evening Mass. There will be a Vigil Mass at 7pm on Wednesday 14th.



August 15th, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of Our Lady and is a Holy Day of Obligation.

In Irish, it is called Lá Fhéile Naomh Muire san Fhómhar, that is, "The Feast Day of Our Lady in the Harvest Time".

The Assumption of Mary is a participation in Christ's resurrection, and gives us hope that we too will share in Christ's glory and come to live fully in God.

This Feast Day is not just about Mary, but about the whole body of the faithful. Mary's glorious assumption is the first moment in the glorious assumption of the Church.
