WICKLOW DEMENTIA SUPPORT Meet and Eat is a new pilot project that aims to target older adults who are socially isolated, living alone, and in particular those who are vulnerable due to physical, mental or cognitive impairment and living in the Roundwood, Laragh, Ashford and Newtownmountkenedy areas. 12 volunteers are being recruited to assist with preparation of nutritious meals and to provide companionship at mealtime once per week in the older persons home. Training will be provided for volunteers.
