A **Festival of Families** on Saturday 25 August, comprising a reflective concert style event within a prayerful and joyful atmosphere, in which personal stories of faith will be shared by families from all continents;
A **Closing Mass** will be celebrated on Sunday 26 August with thousands of people from Ireland and across the world.

Families from all over the world will gather in Dublin from the **21st to the 26th of August 2018**. 2nd SUNDAY OF LENT

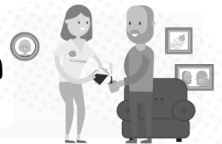
During this Season of Lent, we pray that in times of testing our families will turn to the light of the Gospel to inspire and guide them.
