FR JOHN O'CONNELL

Fr John was ordained on the 26th of May 1957. He went on to study in Rome until 1961. He began his Ministry as a Professor in Clonliffe from 1961 to 1974. Fr John came to Bray in 1974 and was appointed Parish Priest 1981. He retired in 2008 and became Pastor Emeritus and remains so to the present day.

FR ENDA LLOYD

Fr Enda was Ordained in December 1966 and began his Ministry in James Connolly Hospital in 1967. From there he worked as University Chaplain in Maynooth and various Parishes around the Dublin Diocese, including Greystones, Roundwood and Glencullen. He also spent a considerable period of his Ministry in Chile. Fr Enda came to Bray as Parish Priest in 2009 where he remains today.
