On the day, you will need to be prepared for a lot of walking. At a minimum, you will be required to walk 4km to and 4km from the Mass and up to 7km and 7km, depending on where you are coming from. To help you with your journey there will be a number of supports in place. Designated rest zones will be positioned at regular intervals at the transport hubs, along these walking routes and at the gates. Multiple food and drinks stations will also be available, as will medical facilities, toilets and baby changing facilities. There will be volunteers throughout the venue, at the gates and at the hubs who will be able to help you. Facilities will be provided for people with accessibility issues and their carers. This is why you are being asked for your travel route and why you have been requested to plan your transport. This will make your journey quicker and more comfortable for you.
