PROTECTION AGAINST CORONAVIRUS



We have been asked by the Diocese to observe the measures outlined by the HSE in relation to the Coronavirus threat as listed below:

The following should be **suspended:**

- The Sign of Peace Handshake
- The use of holy water fonts
- The practice of receiving Holy Communion on the tongue
- The use of shared chalice

Everyone administering Holy Communion should wash their hands or use alcohol based hand gel before beginning. Holy Communion should be administered into the hands only and not onto the tongue.

To minimise the risk of spread of infection, during Holy Communion, the celebrant alone should drink from the Chalice. No one else should drink from the Chalice, including other priests, ministers of the Eucharist and members of the congregation.

By following the essential advice of both hand hygiene and respiratory hygiene, we will create a safer environment for all. In addition, a calm and common sense approach will also help at this time.
